Ensure that the spray unit is correctly maintained and that an effective mist extraction system is used. Treated timber must not come into contact with foodstuffs, e.g. use in packing cases or places where food is prepared or stored. DO NOT spray directly on exposed food, utensils or food preparation surfaces.

Wood-based Composite Products

Permatek™ IM 200 is recommended for the preservation of wood-based products, such as waferboard, fiberboard and particleboard when it is important to prevent the attack of insects, including termites, on the composite product. Composite wood treated with Permatek™ IM 200 does not change in appearance and may be painted when dry. Permatek™ IM 200 may be applied into a wood composite thorough a number of methods, including:

- a) Metering Permatek™ IM 200 into the dried wood flakes, fibers, etc. immediately before the blender. Permatek™ IM 200 is then mixed with flakes in the blender.
- b) Mixing Permatek™ IM 200 with the wood flakes in the blender.
- c) Mixing Permatek™ IM 200 with the adhesive or wax which is subsequently applied to the flakes in the blender.
- d) Applying Permatek™ IM 200 to the exterior of composite products after manufacture. A penetrating agent will aid treatment.

The method of incorporation of Permatek™ IM 200 will depend on the specific manufacturing process and wood species for the composite. The use level is 0.16 to 0.48 pints Permatek™ IM 200 per cubic yard of composite product.

Wood-based Veneer Products

For the treatment of plywood, LVL and oriented-strand board, Permatek™ IM 200 may be used to treat the veneers before lay-up by dipping, rolling or spraying. If sprayed, apply as a coarse spray. Alternatively Permatek™ IM 200 may be added to the adhesive prior to application to the veneers.

When treating softwood veneer based products for protection against termite (all termites excluding *Mastotermes darwiniensis*), the suggested use level is 0.16 to 0.97 pints Permatek™ IM 200 per cubic yard of wood product.
