FIRST AID

If using on tall vegetation, trees, or bushes hang bags about 1 foot from ground to discourage rabbits and 4 feet from ground to discourage deer. If severe browsing damage exists, place bags closer together. Green Screen® Bags are odor offensive to wildlife and should remain fully exposed. Green Screen® Bags can be used for home and garden.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

For best results use entire content of package within one year of opening package. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry location.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:
