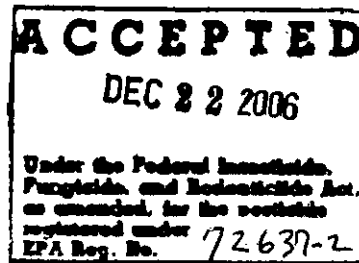

Do not apply Green Screen® Powder directly to vegetation.
