We are concurrently applying for registration with California DPR and this label will be used only in California in order to comply with California DPR.

- I. Citrus Oil Products would like to note the changes to the label.
  - a. Front Label Page
    - 1. Added: For California Only
    - 2. The word "infestation" was removed from the original label.
    - 3. The words Insect and Disease were reversed.
  - b. Second Page:
    - 1. In crop chart, under cucurbits we want to temporarily restricted the product for use on cantaloupes pending further testing in California.
    - 2. Under fruiting vegetables, we want to temporarily remove peppers pending repeat test results in California.
    - 3. Under Application rates, we would like to recommend a lower rate for annuals and row crops pending further testing in California.
  - c. No changes were made to the back of the label
