The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following label changes:

1. The "Statements of Practical Treatment" will need to be updated in accordance with PR Notice 2000-3. (For guidance: www.epa.gov/opppmsd1/PR_Notices/pr2000-3.pdf)

2. The Precautionary statements will need to be updated according to the Label Manual 3rd Edition by stating:

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses), protective clothing, and rubber gloves. Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

3. According to PR Notice 83-3, all pesticide products are required to have storage instructions with an appropriate heading. The section should be placed immediately after the statement, "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal".

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For contact with eyes, call a physician. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: FOR EMERGENCY INFORMATION, 1-800-286-7850. Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

CORROSIVE: Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish.

SWIMMING POOLS

INITIAL DOSE: Add 5 1/4 fluid ounces BAQUACIL ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Add 1 1/4 fluid ounces BAQUACIL ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of pool water. Initial dose is given when filling pool or upon conversion to BAQUACIL. If pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or reappear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added weekly. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

Maintenance dose should be added after a heavy or prolonged rainfall.

If make-up water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1/2 fluid ounce BAQUACIL ALGICIDE for each 1,000 gallons of fresh make-up water added. When swimming season is over, add initial dose prior to closing pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

When BAQUACLOR ALGICIDE is used as directed, it is effective against *Chloroella pyrenoidosa* (green algae), *Paenidium luridum* (black algae), *Lyngbya versicolor* (blue-green algae), and other swimming pool algae and slime producing microorganisms.

For persistent algae or slime producing microorganism growth, add 5-7 1/2 ounces of BAQUACIL ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of pool water into the skimmer with the filter pump running. After one minute, shut off the pump and allow the system to remain off overnight. The following day, restart the filter pump and add 5-7 1/2 ounces of BAQUACIL ALGICIDE to the pool. Run the filter continuously for 24-48 hours, brushing the sides and bottom of the pool frequently.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS: Store in original container in an area inaccessible to children. Keep from freezing.

SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES: Small spills may be mopped up, flushed away with water, or absorbed on some absorbent material and incinerated.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: To dispose of excess product, securely wrap original container in several layers of newspapers and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. To dispose of empty container, rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

BAQUACIL ALGICIDE is compatible with many swimming pool chemicals, and, when used as directed, it is not harmful to the metal, paint, plaster, or tile surfaces of the swimming pool.
