
- delete advisory statements under the heading "coverting from Chlorine" under heading "Freshly Filled, Dechlorinated or Baquacil Pools"

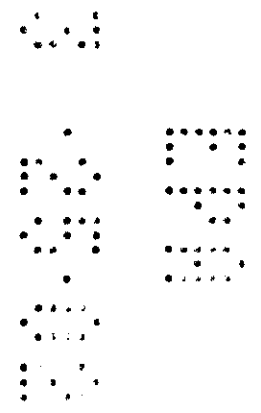

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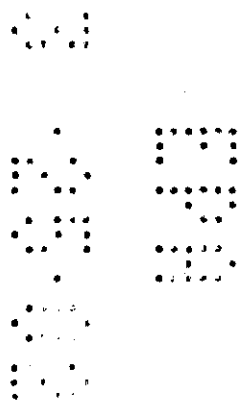

**NORMAL POOL MAINTENANCE**

To properly maintain your pool with BAQUACIL ULTRA Sanitizer during the swimming season, follow these steps on a weekly basis:

Once a week, check the BAQUACIL ULTRA Sanitizer level, pH and total alkalinity in your pool. Adjust pH and total alkalinity if necessary.

The level of BAQUACIL ULTRA Sanitizer should be between 30 and 50 ppm. When the level of BAQUACIL ULTRA Sanitizer is 30ppm or less, add enough BAQUACIL ULTRA Sanitizer to bring the level to 50 ppm. The level of BAQUACIL ULTRA Sanitizer should never be allowed to drop below 30 ppm. To raise the BAQUACIL ULTRA Sanitizer level 10 ppm, add 14 oz. per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

Please remember that BAQUACIL ULTRA Sanitizer and chlorine-based chemicals are not compatible. If you accidentally add chlorine to your swimming pool, refer to the BAQUACIL ULTRA Pool Care Guide for troubleshooting techniques.

Do not use BAQUACIL ULTRA Sanitizer in unpainted plaster pools previously exposed to metals which may cause staining (see BAQUACIL ULTRA Pool Care Guide for specific information).
