DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

BAQUACIL AD™ Algicide 20 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness, pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using BAQUACIL AD™ Algicide 20.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 37 to 56 fluid ounces of BAQUACIL AD™ Algicide 20 per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 20 to 37 fluid ounces of BAQUACIL AD™ Algicide 20 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 7 to 13 fluid ounces of BAQUACIL AD™ Algicide 20 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

- The BAQUACIL AD™ dispensing unit will deliver an initial dose of 20 37 oz. per 10,000 gallons to the pool water.
- After about 24 hours, take a water sample to your Authorized BAQUACIL® Dealer for complete water analysis.

NORMAL POOL MAINTENANCE

To properly maintain your pool with BAQUACIL AD™ Algicide 20 through the swimming season, follow these steps:

- Once a week, check the BAQUACIL AD™ Sanitizer and Algistat concentration, using the BAQUACIL®
