Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

- Insert the SanisorbX pouches through the port of the suction canister. See table below for applicable number of pouches depending on size of suction canister
- SanisorbX is effective for suction canister contents up to 30% blood serum.
- Recap port and allow 30 minutes for solidification before handling.
- Dispose of treated medical waste in compliance with local, state, and federal regulations.
- If pouch opening and solidification does not occur, handle as untreated medical waste following local, state, and federal regulations.
