

- c. Revise the precautionary statement to read as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin, or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."

- d. The First Aid statement must be revised to read as follows:

"First Aid"

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 1-20 minutes. Call Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.



Dosage: 3 g per 2.1 quart (2 liter) of water.

Directions:

- **Hygiene:** Use only clean buckets, containers and other materials. Clean and disinfect with cleaner.
- **Buckets and containers:** Do not use buckets and containers of unprotected ferrous metal (zinc, copper, iron). The acidic solution can cause rust building which reduce vase life.
- **Type of water:** Preferably use tap water. When using spring or rain water, a filter must be installed previous to the dosing unit.
- **Active life of the solution:** Reusable for 3 – 7 days, depending on the number of flowers treated and the temperature. The solution will remain effective for a longer period of time when used at lower temperatures. Do not add residual solutions to fresh ones.
- **Dispensing equipment:** Check the dispenser unit frequently to ensure proper functioning.

Dissolving process: Dispense the product first before filling with water, in order to enhance the dissolving process. Once the bucket and vases is handled the powder dissolves quickly from the water turbulence.
