- c. Revise the precautionary statement to read as follows:

“Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin, or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid breathing dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.”  
Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

- d. The First Aid statement must be revised to read as follows:

**“First Aid”**

- **Wholesalers:** Flowers can stay in this solution up to 3 days, preferably in cold storage.
- **Bouquet makers:** Flowers should be hydrated at a minimum of 4 hours before assembling them into bouquets.
- **Florists:** Upon arrival, hydrate flowers in a cooler for a minimum of 4 hours or until needed.
- **Type of water:** Preferably use tap water. When using well or rainwater, a filter must be installed previous to the dosing unit.
- **Active life of the solution:** Can be reused up to one week, if kept in a cooler.

**Acidity:** The solution is acidic. Use in contact with this solution only acid-proof pumps, pipes, hoses (E.P.D.M. rubber) and other materials.

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
