Dear Dr. Sharp:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Add the *cis:trans* isomer ratio for cypermethrin as on the previously accepted label. You need not include the chemical name of the active ingredient in the ingredient statement, but you must still include the *cis:trans* ratio as a footnote to the ingredient statement.
- 2. Add Inhalation First Aid statements, since the product is classified in category III by the inhalation route of exposure:

If inhaled:	Move person to fresh air.
	If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give
	artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
	Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

- 3. Make the following changes to the Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals:
 - Change "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin" to "Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin."
 - Add "Avoid breathing spray mist."
- 4. Revise the statement "NOT FOR USE IN <u>USDA</u> MEAT AND POULTRY PLANTS" to read: "NOT FOR USE IN <u>FEDERALLY INSPECTED</u> MEAT AND POULTRY PLANTS."

NOT FOR USE IN USDA MEAT AND POULTRY PLANTS.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food/feed is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods/feeds are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods/feeds may be prepared or held. In the home, all food/feed processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before reuse. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed. Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, basements, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage rooms (after canning and bottling).

Cyper-Active insecticide is intended for dilution with water for spray application.

Fill sprayer with the desired volume of water and add Cyper-Active insecticide. Close and shake before use in order to insure proper mixing. Shake or reagitate sprayer before use if spraying is interrupted. Make up only as required.

INDOORS

Cockroaches, Spiders, Crickets, Silverfish and Firebrats: Apply as a coarse, low pressure spray to areas where these pests hide, such as baseboards, corners, storage areas, closets, around water pipes, doors and windows, attics and eaves, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks, furnaces, and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers and similar areas. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices.

Ants: To kill ants within buildings and homes, spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray directly on ants where possible.

Carpenter Ants: Make spot applications as a spray to any trails, around doors and windows, wall voids, crawl spaces, and other places where ants enter premises. Where possible, treat ant nest or infested wood directly.

Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until the spray has dried.

Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets, Bees: Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, especially under attic rafters, contacting as many insects as possible.

Sombugs, Pillbugs, Millipedes, Earwigs, and Centipedes: Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may be found or where they may enter premises. Spray baseboards, storage areas and other locations. Refer to barrier treatment directions to prevent infestation.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths: Apply directly to walls, ceilings, window screens, and other flying insect resting areas as a residual surface treatment. May be used inside residential buildings as well as in and around carports, garages, and storage sheds.

To Control Fleas and Ticks: Apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not treat pets with this product.

OUTDOORS

Do not apply this product to edible crops.

Ants. Bees, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Firebrats, Millipedes, Silverfish, Sombugs, Spiders, Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets. Apply as a residual spray to surfaces of buildings, porches, screens, window frames, eaves, patios, lawns, refuse dumps, garages in either hand or power sprayer. Treat other areas where these pests are found.

To Control Fleas and Ticks: Apply Cyper-Active to areas where fleas and ticks are most likely to be found, such as, but not limited to, dog houses, kennels runways, cracks and crevices in sidewalks, paths or patios where pests may rest.

BARRIER TREATMENT: To help prevent infestation of buildings, apply to a band of soil and vegetation 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the building. Also, treat the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where pests are active and may find entrance. Apply as a coarse spray to thoroughly and uniformly wet the band area, using 1 gallon of spray mix per 400 square feet.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container.

Storage: Store product in original container and keep container closed when not in use. Do not store near food or feed. Protect from freezing. In case of spill or leak on floor or paved surfaces, soak up with sand, earth or synthetic absorbent. Remove to chemical waste area.
