PyraPerm Insect Killer WBA N67
EPA Registration No. 73049-323
Your submission dated May 28, 2003

Dear Dr. Sharp:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

1. Under the "Precautionary Labeling" section of your label, move the following statements to the "Directions for Use" section: "Avoid contamination...surfaces are dry." Delete the statement "Causes skin irritation" and replace with "Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing."
2. Delete the word "highly" from the statement "...broad spectrum insecticide highly effective..."
3. Add the following statement to the "Directions for Use" section: "Do not apply to institutions (including libraries, sports facilities, etc.) in the immediate area when occupants are present."
4. The results of the acute inhalation study indicate it is in Toxicity Category III. Therefore reinstate the first aid inhalation statement and corresponding language under Precautionary Statements.
5. Add the following precaution to the first paragraph under Outdoors "Remove all exposed food and cooking utensils. Cover all food handling surfaces or wash thoroughly after treatment and before use. Do not use on edible crops

6. Revise the first sentence under Crawling Insects to read "Hold can two (2) to three (3) feet from surface to be treated and spray in infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Spray to slightly moisten the surface."

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Causes skin irritation. Do not get on skin or clothing. Frequent or repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to any body of water.

Physical and Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not apply this product in conduits, motor housings, junction boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before use. Cover or remove exposed food.

Non-food/non-feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning and bottling).

Do not use in rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Do not use on electrical equipment or on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

When treating surfaces and fabrics where water alone could stain, spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration.

INDOORS:

Houseflies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Blackflies, Skipper Flies, Blow Flies and Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room, moving toward the door. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible.

Indian Meal Moths, Angoumois Grain Moths: Close doors and windows, direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product containers, pallets and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space, moving toward the door. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment.

Expose stages of **Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Granary Weevils, Grain Mites:** Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers or other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Dispose of infested stored product food products in the home.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray in joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

TO CONTROL *Clothes Moths and Other Carpet Beetles* on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

OUTDOORS:

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for the product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

FLYING INSECTS: *Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Hornets and Yellow Jackets*. Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes, or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles.

CRAWLING INSECTS: *Ants, Cockroaches, including Asian Cockroaches, Crickets, Centipedes, and Silverfish*. Spray infested surfaces of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

FOR THE CONTROL OF GARDEN INSECTS: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill *Japanese Beetles* hit by spray, as well as *Whiteflies, Aphids, exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites and Leafminers*.

May be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas.

May also be used on other plants such as African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English ivy, euonymus, fuchsia, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering Jews and zinnias.

Effective when used as directed against *Whiteflies, Aphids, Spider and Red Mites, Exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Japanese Beetles, Pavement Ants, Clover Mites and Armyworms*. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90°F. Contact insects directly whenever possible.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area. Do not transport or store below 32°F.

Disposal: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
