- 2) Addition of black fly as a pest. This pest has been approved previously for one of the end-use products in which this manufacturing-use product is used as a registered source.
- 3) Addition of "Manufactured for:" before the company name in accordance with Chapter 15 of the Label Review Manual and 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 156.10(c).
- 4) Modification of the First Aid and Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals statements so that they coincide with the toxicity categories obtained from the supporting data.
- 5) Revision of the Storage and Disposal statements in accordance with Pesticide Registration (PR) Notices 2007-4 and 83-3.
- 6) Addition of "To the extent consistent with applicable law" to the Notice To User section in order to eliminate a potential false or misleading statement.
