


**Pest Control on Outside Surfaces and Around Buildings (Outdoor Non-Food):** Perimeter Treatments (applied to and around outside surfaces of residential and non-residential buildings and structures, including, but not limited to: crawl spaces, decks, driveways, eaves, fences, foundations, garages, patios, refuse dumps, walkways, walls, window and door frames and general outdoor treatments (for flying and crawling insects). Application to ornamental plants, flowers, shrubs and trees.
