The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the referenced product in connection with the **REDs for PERMETHRIN and PIPERONYL BUTOXIDE**, and have concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

## General Comment(s):

1. Delete all text throughout the label marked with "strikethrough."

#### Ingredient Statement section comment(s):

- 2. In order to incorporate required label changes from the acute toxicology review completed in support of this product, make the following changes within this section:
  - Revise the listing of "Piperonyl butoxide, Technical\*\*" to read "Piperonyl butoxide\*\*"
  - Revise the 2<sup>nd</sup> footnote to read "\*\*(butylcarbityl) (6-propylpiperonyl) ether and related compounds"

#### First Aid Statement section comment(s):

- 3. In order to incorporate required label changes from the acute toxicology review completed in support of this product, make the following changes within this section:
  - Insert the following text (new row) immediately following the existing "If swallowed:" to read as follows:

If on skin or clothing:	Take off contaminated clothing.	
	<ul> <li>Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.</li> </ul>	
	Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.	

• Revise the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence within the "**HOT LINE NUMBER**" subsection to read "For additional information on this product (including health concerns, medical emergencies, or pesticide incidents), you may call 1-877-315-9819, twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week."

  - Insert the following new text immediately following the existing/revised 2<sup>nd</sup> bulleted statement as follows: "Goggles or face shield."
  - Revise the existing statement starting with "In addition to the above PPE, applicators using hand-held foggers in an enclosed area ..." to read "Applicators using hand-held foggers or fog/mist generators in indoor spaces must wear coveralls over long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material, chemical-resistant footwear plus socks, goggles or face shield, chemical-resistant headgear, if overhead exposure, and a half-face, full-face, or hood-style NIOIS-approved respirator with a dust/mist filtering cartridge (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C), or a cartridge or canister approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-14G), or a cartridge or canister with any N, R, P, or HE filter."

7. In order to incorporate required label changes from the REDs for permethrin and piperonyl butoxide, revise the first 2 paragraphs within this subsection to read as follows:

"This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. Do not apply directly to or near water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean water mark. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Drift and run-off from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash waters. See Directions for Use for additional precautions and use restrictions.

Under some conditions, this product may also have a potential for transport into surface water in run-off (primarily adsorbed to suspended soil particles), for several months or more after application. These include poorly draining or wet soils with readily visible slopes toward adjacent surface waters, frequently flooded areas, and areas overlying extremely shallow groundwater, areas with in-field canals or ditches that drain to surface water, areas not separated from adjacent surface waters with vegetated filter strips, and areas over-lying tile drainage systems that drain to surface waters.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively visiting the treatment area."

- 9. Revise the existing subsection heading "GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND USE RESTRICTIONS" to read "USE RESTRICTIONS"
- 10. In order to incorporate required label changes from the REDs for permethrin and piperonyl butoxide, make the following changes within this subsection:
  - Insert the following text immediately preceding the existing 2<sup>nd</sup> bulleted statement as follows: "Not for use in metered release systems."
  - Insert the following text immediately following the newly inserted bulleted statement added above as follows: "DO NOT USE ON CATS OR KITTENS. <u>Do not treat cats or their bedding</u>. <u>This product may</u> be toxic or potentially fatal if applied to or ingested by cats or kittens."

# Directions for Use, GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND USE RESTRICTIONS subsection comment(s), continued:

- Insert the following text immediately following the newly inserted bulleted statement added above as follows: "Do not apply this product to puppies less than 12 weeks old."

#### **Agricultural Use Requirements**

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 12 hours.

PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard, and that involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water is:

- Coveralls
- Shoes plus socks
- Chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material

  - Revise the existing statement "Do not apply when food or feed is present." to read "Do not apply when food, feed, or water is present. Do not apply directly to non-domestic/commercial (livestock) animals."
  - Insert the following new text immediately following the existing statement starting with "Direct nozzles to spray towards ..." as follows: "The pesticide container must be locked."
  - Insert the following new text immediately following the existing statement starting with "Do not use in misters located within ..." as follows: "Do not use in an evaporative cooling system."

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN OUTDOOR RESIDENTIAL MISTING SYSTEMS subsection comment(s):

- In order to incorporate required label changes from the REDs for permethrin and piperonyl butoxide. make the following changes within this subsection:
  - Within the existing statement starting with "Residential misting system installers ...," replace the words "Residential misting system installers" with the words "When using this product, installers and ..."
  - Within the existing statement starting with "When applying the end use dilution ...," revise the 1st sentence to read "If used in a system with a with a reservoir tank for the end use dilution, the reservoir tank must be locked."
  - Revise the existing statements starting with "If a direct injection system is used ..." to read "If used in a direct injection system, the pesticide container must be locked. Securely attach the end use label to the pesticide container in a weather protected area or plastic sleeve."

#### Storage and Disposal, Container Disposal subsection comment(s):

In order to be compliant with PR Notice 2007-4, revise the "CONTAINER DISPOSAL:" subsection to read: 15.

"CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank, or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling if available or reconditioning if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities."

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Within 10 working days of the date of this letter, you must submit an amended reregistration label incorporating all of the above changes. If we do not receive an amended label in response to this letter, this registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

**PLEASE NOTE:** This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(q) of FIFRA at this time.
