

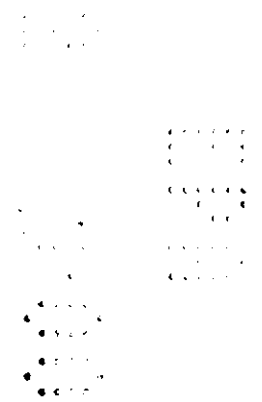

Excessive levels of copper increases the possibility of stains (from copper salts) on liner and accessory surfaces; this *should not* occur when using ECLIPSE-3 if instructions are followed. Pre-treating pool water with a heavy metal sequestering product will reduce the risk of stains.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store unused product in original container only in a cool, dry area out of reach of children and animals.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ECLIPSE-3 has been designed and proven to be an efficient chlorine reducer, pH stabilizer, algicide and water clarifier for use in Swimming Pools, Hot Tubs and Spas.

Water must be analyzed and corrected as per directions prior to ECLIPSE-3 treatment.

FOR SPRING START-UP

Shock treat pool with chlorine or bromine following supplier's recommended label rate. Balance water alkalinity in the range of 80 – 150 ppm. Maintain pH between 7.2 and 7.6.

Add 2oz. of Eclipse-3 per 1,000 gallons of pool water; use measuring cup provided in pail.

After treatment run filtration system continuously for 48 hours; backwash at 12 hour intervals. Vacuum after 24 hours to remove any sediment collected by ECLIPSE-3.

One week after spring start-up treatment, begin weekly applications of Eclipse-3 using the directions below.

WEEKLY APPLICATION

Add 1/8th oz. of Eclipse-3 per 1,000 gallons weekly; use measuring cup provided in pail. After starting weekly applications, run filtration system 8 hours daily.

Maintain proper chlorine or bromine level. Check alkalinity every 2 months. Maintain a pH of approximately 7.4.

NOTES

1. **ONLY** use measuring cup provided with ECLIPSE-3.
2. Distribute ECLIPSE-3 close to surface near discharge jets to reduce the risk of staining accessory surfaces.
3. Daily monitoring of chlorine/bromine may be needed during periods of heavy traffic and high temperatures.
4. When having water tested, a copper reading of 1 – 3 ppm should be obtained.
5. This product **does not** contain any bleaching agents to remove stains.
