Shock treat water with chlorine or bromine following supplier's recommended label rate. Balance water alkalinity in the range of 80 - 150 ppm. Maintain pH between 7.2 and 7.6.

Add 2 oz. of ECLIPSE3 per 1,000 gallons of water; use measuring cup provided in pail.
