Water must be analyzed and corrected as per directions prior to ECLIPSE3 treatment.

FOR SPRING START-UP

Shock treat water with chorine or bromine following supplier's recommended label rate. Balance water alkalinity in the range of 80-150 ppm. Maintain pH between 7.2 and 7.6.

Add 2 oz. of ECLIPSE3 per 1,000 gallons of water; use measuring cup provided in pail.

After treatment, run filtration system continuously for 48 hours; backwash at 12-hour intervals. Vacuum after 24 hours to remove any sediment collected by ECLIPSE3.

One week after spring start-up treatment, begin weekly applications of ECLIPSE3 using the directions below.

WEEKLY APPLICATION

Add 1/8th oz. of ECLIPSE3 per 1,000 gallons weekly; use measuring cup provided in pail. After starting weekly applications, run filtration system 8 hours daily.

Maintain proper chlorine or bromine level. Check alkalinity every 2 months. Maintain a pH of approximately 7.4.

NOTES

- 1. Only use measuring cup provided with ECLIPSE3.
- 2. Distribute ECLIPSE3 close to surface near discharge jets to reduce the risk of staining accessory surfaces.
- 3. Daily monitoring of chlorine/bromine may be needed during periods of heavy traffic and high temperatures.
- 4. When having water tested, a copper reading of 1-3 ppm should be obtained.
- 5. This product *does not* contain any bleaching agents to remove stains.
