3. Revise the "net contents" statement to read as follows:


"The net contents per container for antimicrobial products must conform to the requirements listed in 40 Code of Federal Regulations. The net contents statement must be expressed as avoirdupois pounds and ounces to be placed on the label. It must take into account the weight of the wipe material plus the liquid product added to the wipe material. The Agency has no objection to the use of an additional statement indicating the number of premoistened wipes and the individual dimensions of each."

4. Submit three (3) copies of the final printed label prior to releasing this product for sale.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General Information: This product can be used food contact surfaces such as sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage, food trays, tables and chairs, appliances, grocery carts, thermometers, proximity switches, control panels, tools, door handles, scales, display equipment and other hard, non-porous surfaces. Do not use this product to sanitize eating utensils, dishes, glassware, cookware, wood cutting boards and surfaces that are porous or areas that the wipe cannot reach or penetrate.

Alpet D2 Surface Sanitizing Wipes is a ready-to-use surface sanitizer that kills 99.999% of the following bacteria in 60 seconds on hard, non-porous surfaces: *Staphylococcus aureus* (ATCC 6538) and *Escherichia coli* (ATCC 11299).

Dispensing Directions: Unscrew lid counter-clockwise and remove. Remove seal from top of container. Remove and discard center tube. From center of towel roll, pull up wipe corner and feed through the center hole starting from the underside of the lid. Once wipe is exposed through the top of the lid, screw lid (clockwise) back onto the container. Pull wipes from container as needed and use immediately after removal from container. Ensure the wipe is visibly wet (saturated) before use. Note: the spring-loaded lid will close itself to ensure each wipe stays saturated and to prevent drying.

To Sanitize: Use Alpet D2 Surface Sanitizing Wipes on pre-cleaned surfaces only. On a clean surface, use Alpet D2 Surface Sanitizing Wipes to sanitize as directed. Treated surfaces must remain saturated for 60 seconds in order to achieve sanitization. Let air dry. Do not rinse. Discard wipe when it no longer saturates the surface or becomes dry. Do not reuse wipes that have dried out.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Keep this product under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or people unfamiliar with its proper use. Store in a cool dry area away from flames, sparks or other sources of heat or ignition. If ignited, use dry chemical or CO₂ extinguisher.
