

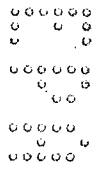

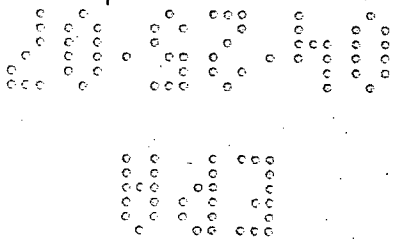

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Outdoor Use:

For large, infested areas: Using a hand-held granular spreader, broadcast AMDRO at 2 to 4 ounces per 5,000 square feet.
