


3. Change the Precautionary statements to read as follows:



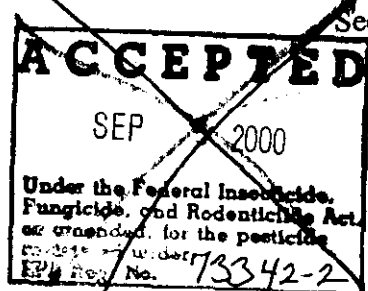

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)

#### CAUTION!

**May be harmful if swallowed.** Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Pets may be attracted to AMDRO insecticide ant bait, so keep them away from treated areas for at least 24 hours after application.

**Statement of Practical Treatment:** If swallowed, drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

**Environmental Hazards:** This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from target areas.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Keep people and pets out of the area during application.

AMDRO insecticide ant bait is for use ONLY on lawns, golfcourses, grounds, parks, ornamental gardens, rangeland, pasture, and other noncropland for control of the Texas leafcutting ant.

This product is not for use on crops, timber, plants or turf grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production or for research purposes. Do not use AMDRO insecticide ant bait on vegetable or other food crops.

**Outdoor Use:** AMDRO insecticide ant bait controls the Texas leafcutting ant. AMDRO insecticide ant bait is for use on lawns, landscaped areas, golf courses, ornamental gardens and other noncropland areas such as airports, roadsides, cemeteries, commercial grounds, parks, school grounds, picnic grounds, athletic fields and other recreational areas, as well as on grounds surrounding poultry houses (excluding runs and ranges) or corrals and other animal holding areas. Avoid direct exposure of animals to AMDRO granules.

Do not graze or feed treated lawn or sod clippings to livestock.

Treatment	Rate	Comments
Individual mounds: Texas leafcutting ant	$\frac{3}{4}$ lb./colony	Locate the central concentration of mounds, indicating the location of the colony. Apply AMDRO bait directly onto and around mounds using a disposable spoon or measuring cup. Do not contaminate kitchen utensils by use or storage. Do not apply more than 2.0 lb. per acre.
Broadcast treatment: Texas leafcutting ant	1.5 lb./acre [3.0 oz./5,000 square feet]	Bait can be broadcast using spreader/seeder equipment.

Applications can be made any time that ants are active. However, AMDRO insecticide ant bait should not be applied to wet ground or grass, or if rain is expected within 24 hours, or when temperatures are below 50°F. Avoid leaving the bait exposed to direct sunlight for prolonged periods. During hot weather, application is best performed in the early morning or early evening when temperatures are cooler and ants are active.

Check treated colonies for ant activity 30-40 days after treatment. Repeat applications as needed.

**Grass Forage (Pasture and Rangeland) Use:** AMDRO insecticide ant bait controls the Texas leafcutting ant. AMDRO insecticide ant bait may only be applied to grass forage (pasture and rangeland) for the control of ants in Texas and Louisiana. Use of AMDRO insecticide ant bait on ~~pasture and rangeland~~ grass forage in states other than those listed is unlawful. Avoid direct exposure of animals to AMDRO granules. Reference the table below for application directions. Applications of AMDRO insecticide ant bait to ~~pastures and rangeland~~ grass forage may not exceed a maximum rate of 8.0 pounds per acre per year, and AMDRO may not be applied more than 4 times per year with minimum application intervals of 90 days. Do not cut and bale hay from pastures and rangeland treated with AMDRO insecticide ant bait until 7 days after the bait application is made. The restrictions on the use of AMDRO on cutting and baling hay do not apply when the treated pasture and rangeland is used solely to support companion animals (e.g., horses, llamas). These companion animals cannot be used for food or feed.

#### WHY AMDRO INSECTICIDE ANT BAIT IS SO EFFECTIVE:

1. AMDRO insecticide ant bait is highly attractive to the Texas leafcutting ant. AMDRO insecticide ant bait granules are carried directly into the mound by workers as food for the colony.
2. Inside the mound, AMDRO insecticide ant bait is passed to the queen, as well as to other ants. By the end of one to four weeks, the queen and most of the ants in the mound will have eaten this product and died.
3. When the queen is dead, no new worker ants can be produced, so the mound dies.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Prohibitions:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**Storage:** Store in cool, dry, secure place and keep container tightly closed. Store container away from pets. This product is formulated in an oil bait. Prolonged exposure to air may turn oil rancid and reduce the attractiveness of the bait. Use within 3 months after opening.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**Container Disposal:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

**General:** Consult Federal, State, or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.
