For best results, apply when ants are active (typically when soil temperature is greater than 60°F). Repeat application as needed.

This product controls imported and native fire ants and other ants, such as harvester ants and bigheaded ants, and Argentine ants. This product is for use ONLY on lawns, landscaped areas, golf courses, commercial grounds, parks and other noncropland areas, as well as on grounds surrounding poultry houses (excluding runs and ranges) or corrals and other animal holding areas. Avoid direct exposure of animals to this product.

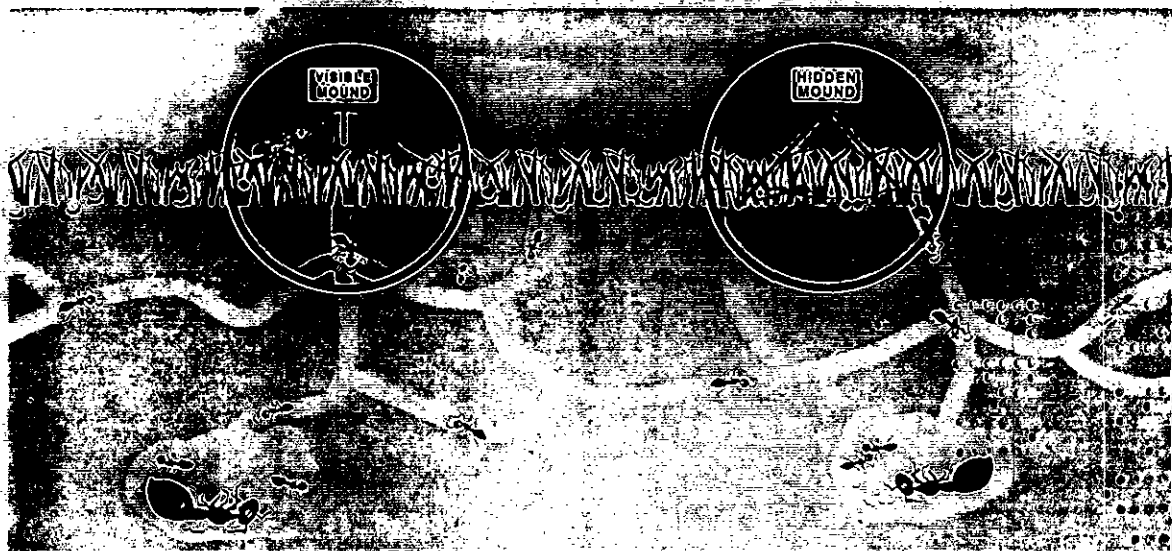
