On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. - b. Remove the following label claims:
 - Remove the following label claims:
 - Destroys the mound. (Use of language implying complete control is not permitted)
 - Kills fire ants through out the entire yard. (The product is not likely to kill fire ants far from the treatment area.)
 - Destroys visible and hidden mounds [!] (See a. above.)
 - Starts to kill ants immediately. (A bait would not be effective if this was true.)
 - Fast acting bait kills the queen fast. (See d. above.)
 - Eliminated fire ant colonies. (See a. above.)
 - Fast acting. Long Lasting. Controls fire ants up to one year. (Submit or cite data demonstrating any/each of these claims.)
- c. Under "How Amdro fire ant bait yard treatment plus works", revise as follows:
 - Remove "with specific activity against fire ants"
 - Remove "It starts to kill immediately."
 - Reword or remove the underlined text from "the entire colony starves"... and ... "which destroys the mound".
 - Reword or remove the underlined text from "Control of visible mounds is immediate"...
- d. Under directions for use, "Repeat application as needed" should be bounded by an upper limit

3. Within one year from this date of issuance (identified above) , Ambrands must submit the following confirmatory product chemistry data to satisfy the outstanding data gaps:

a. Submit product's oxidation/reduction: chemical incompatibility and storage stability, two product chemistry data requirements of GRNs 830.6314 & 830.6317, respectively.

4. Ambrands must Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record, and a letter of agreement to satisfy the outstanding product chemistry data gaps identified in #3 above.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

(11 lb. per 11,000 to 22,000 sq. ft.; 7.5 lb. per 7,500 to 15,000 sq. ft.; 5.5 lb. per 5,500 to 11,000 sq. ft.; 2.5 lb. per 2,500 to 5,000 sq. ft.)
