On behalf of ISP Minerals, Inc., I am submitting a notification for the product Copper Color Guard Algae-Resistant Roof Granules (EPA Reg. No. 73452-2). The purpose of this notification is to update the storage and disposal section per PR Notice 2007-4. Please note that we did not update the container language for railcars and trucks because these types of containers are exempt from the new language requirements.

Notification of label change per PR Notice 2007-4. This notification is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product.
