FIRST AID	
If in eyes:	 Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes; then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

The formulated end-use products can be used at the following sites: food-handling premises, food or feed containers or dispensers, feed additive for use in cattle feeds*, pets and domestic animals and their man- made premises, households, aquatic sites, wide area and general indoor/outdoor food and nonfood treatments, commercial, domestic, and industrial uses.

Efficacy data will be required by the U.S. EPA for the registration of any end-use product used for the control of pests that pose a threat to human health.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a dry place away from extreme heat and cold (tightly closed at or below 77°F or 25°C. Avoid excessive heat (40°C; 104°F). Keep container closed when not in use. In the event of spillage or leakage, soak up material with absorbent clay, sand, sawdust, or other absorbent material. Scrape up and dispose of in accordance with information given under PESTICIDE DISPOSAL section below.

Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ½ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Then offer for recycling, if available. Or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities.
