

MarketQuest One Drop Flea & Tick Control with Nylar® Insect Growth Regulator

Dear Ms. Horton:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments below. Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. The ingredient statement is generally required on the front panel. If the size or form of the package makes it impractical to place the ingredient statement on the front panel of the label, permission may be granted for the ingredient statement to appear elsewhere [40 CFR 156.10(g)(2)]. Your label indicates that the ingredient statement may appear on either the front, back or side panel. Before EPA will approve placement of the ingredient statement on the side or back panel, you must submit an explanation as to why it is not practical to place the ingredient statement on the front panel. Generally, EPA will not approve alternate placements of the ingredient statement to accommodate pictures, graphics or other marketing claims not required by FIFRA. Until alternate placement is approved, the ingredient statement must appear on the front panel.

2. You must revise the minimum retreatment interval from 3 weeks to 4 weeks. In the companion animal safety study you submitted to support treatment of dogs as young as 3 months (MRID # 459127-01), test animals received a single dose of the test substance. In accordance with EPA test guidelines, retreatment is required unless the minimum retreatment interval for the product is 30 days or more. Since test animals in the submitted study received only a single dose,

you must increase the retreatment interval on the label to 4 weeks (roughly a month). A copy of the Agency's review of the companion animal safety study is enclosed for your records.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO NOT USE ON CATS or animals other than dogs. May be toxic and potentially fatal if applied to or ingested by cats.

Do not get this product in your dog's eyes or mouth. Repeat applications may be made if necessary, but do not apply more often than once every 3 weeks.

[For Dogs Weighing 15 lbs and Under: (1.0 ml applicator tubes) Apply one tube (1.0 ml) of this product as a spot or stripe to the dog's back between the shoulder blades.]

[For Dogs Weighing Between 15 and 33 lbs: (1.5 ml applicator tubes) Apply one tube (1.5ml) of this product as a spot or stripe to the dog's back between the shoulder blades.]

[For Dogs Weighing Between 33 and 66 lbs: (1.5 ml applicator tubes) Apply one tube (1.5 ml) of this product as a spot or stripe to the dog's back between the shoulder blades and apply a second tube (1.5 ml) as a spot or stripe to the dog's back directly in front of the base of the tail.]

OR

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[(3.0 ml applicator tubes) Apply approximately half of the tube (1.5 ml) of this product as a spot or stripe to the dog's back between the shoulder blades and apply the rest of the tube's contents (1.5 ml) as a spot or stripe to the dog's back directly in front of the base of the tail.]

OR

[Apply the entire tube (3.0 ml) as a continuous stripe on the dog's back starting between the shoulder blades and ending directly in front of the base of the tail.]

[For Dogs Weighing 66 lbs and Over: (1.5 ml applicator tubes) Apply one tube (1.5 ml) of this product as a stripe to the dog's back between the shoulder blades <u>and</u> apply a second tube (1.5 ml) continuing the stripe down the center of the dog's back <u>and</u> apply a third tube (1.5 ml) to the dog's back directly in front of the base of the tail.]

[(4.5 ml applicator tubes) Apply approximately half of the tube (2.25 ml) of this product as a spot or stripe to the dog's back between the shoulder blades <u>and</u> apply the rest of the tube's contents (2.25 ml) as a spot or stripe to the dog's back directly in front of the base of the tail.]

[Apply the entire tube (4.5 ml) as a continuous stripe on the dog's back starting between the shoulder blades and ending directly in front of the base of the tail.]

HOW TO APPLY: [FOR SARAN TUBES IN BLISTER CARD: Remove product tube from package. Holding tube with notched end pointing up and away from face and body, snap or cut off narrow end at notches. [FOR FLAT CARD (doubled) UNIT-DOSE PACKAGING: Separate cards along the perforated line. Holding separated card by its wide end with narrow end pointing up and away from face and body, cut along dotted line. Invert card over dog and use narrow end of the card to part dog's hair.
