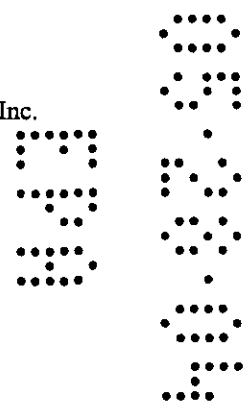

Cerexagri, Inc. herein submits registration amendments for Topsin M 70WP (EPA Reg. No. 73545-11), Topsin 4.5FL (EPA Reg. No. 73545-13) and Topsin M WSB (EPA Reg. No. 73545-16) consistent with the notification provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46.

This amendment reflects the addition to the labels of these thiophanate-methyl end-use products the new genus name *Podospaera* formerly called *Sphaerotheca* as the cause of the disease Powdery Mildew on cucurbits. *Sphaerotheca* has recently been reclassified by taxonomists as *Podospaera*. Adding this new name to these labels will keep them up to date with University recommendations and keeping the old name, *Sphaerotheca*, will help in the transition.

Enclosed please find the following materials to support this registration notification:

1. Completed Application for Pesticide Registration forms (EPA Form 8570-1) for Topsin M 70WP, Topsin 4.5FL, and Topsin M WSB.
2. For each product, two (2) copies of a supplemental label with directions for use on cucurbits to control Powdery Mildew. One of the copies for each product has the addition clearly marked. This disease will be added to the main Section 3 package labels at the next printing.
