United Phosphorus, Inc. as agent for Nisso TM LLC hereby notifies the Agency of our intent to revise the labels for a number of our registered pesticide products containing the active ingredient thiophanate-methyl.

These labelinotifications include revision of the Storage and Disposal text in order to comply with the fequirements of PR Notice 2007-4 regarding Labeling Revisions Required by the Final Rule "Pesticide Management and Disposal; Standards for Pesticide Containers and Containment." In addition, per the Agency guidance in PR Notice 2001-5, the Fungicide Resistance Action Committee (FRAC) mode of action group code has been added to the first page of these labels. The warranty statements on two of these labels (73545-14 and 73545-15) have also been modified.

These changes are consistent with the notification provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46. Enclosed please find the following materials for each of the four products to support these registration notifications:

Use at the higher rate of 21-28 pounds product per acre (1.05 - 1.4 lbs a.i./A) if the field to be planted has a history of these damping-off diseases, has been mono-cropped (beans after beans), or if optimum disease conditions exist at planting, i.e. cool and wet soil.

When <u>Pythium</u> spp. is also a potential problem, this product should be used in combination with a fungicide that controls this pathogen.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in the original container in a dry area. Do not store in a manner where cross-contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food or feed could occur.
