Restrictions

Do not place product in exposed locations where there is likely to be direct contact with children or pets. Do not paint ARINIX II parts.

ARINIX II is specially formulated plastic that contains an insect repellent. ARINIX II effectively repels spiders (except Black Widow and Brown Recluse), ants (except carpenter and pharaoh), beetles, moths, and silverfish. ARINIX II is available as spiral wraps, flat bars or "bug bumpers" and can be used in applications in which prevention of the above pests is needed. Examples of applications include AC cable or power line cords; base or door trim on electrical power supply boxes; area around transmitter boxes and vending machines; transformer, control relay wiring boards; security or fire alarms; monitoring cameras and sensors; ventilation openings around building foundations; home or office ventilation systems; home or office entrances, exits, windows or cargo doors; compressors, animal holding facilities, flower pots and planters; sewage and sewer or drainpipes; electrical switches and sensors used to control irrigation devices; lighting and HVAC systems.

To Use: Remove the plastic bags holding ARINIX II from the cardboard box container. Then open the plastic bag and remove for installation onto target area. When using around electrical transformers, apply enough product to provide a continuous barrier around the perimeter or circumference of the application surface and in such a manner that no space exists between the product and the surface to which it is being applied. Replace Arinix II containing plastic as necessary. Keep Arinix II parts clean.

[Note to Reviewer: These are Alternate Use Directions for AC Drain Hose Applications:]

- 1. Remove the ARINIX II from packaging.
- 2. Insert the ARINIX II into the AC drain hose. Ensure the shoulder of the ARINIX II is fully seated into the AC drain hose.]
