I. Labeling notification per Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 2007-4:

April 14, 2009: An Agency letter with comments prepared by Ms. Joanne I. Miller stated that this product was re-registered.

January 21, 2013: We ask to revise the disposal instructions and to adopt the exact language of Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN 2007-4), Labeling Revisions Required by the Final Rule "Pesticide Management and Disposal: Standards for Pesticide Containers and Containment."

Please refer to pages 2-3 of the draft labeling.

Certification: This notification is consistent with the guidance PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to the EPA. I further understand that if this amended labeling is not consistent with the terms of 40 CFR 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under Section 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
