We would like to make changes to our Gourmet Ant Bait Gel label via the notification process. The first change is related to PR notice 2007-1 (see below)

We would like to remove the directions to call "1-800-Cleanup" from our label as per PR notice 2007-1. Here is our certification that no other changes other than those noted on this letter are being made.

"Notification of label change relative to PR Notice 2007-1. This notification is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-1 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR 156.10 and 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the guidance of PR Notice 2007-1 and the requirements of 40 CFR 156.10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA."

We would further like to make changes to our Gourmet Ant Bait Gel label via the notification process related to PR notice 2007-4 (see below)

We would like to replace our current disposal instructions with:

"DISPOSAL: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If Empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain."

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Figure 1 consists of 16 small plots arranged in a 4x4 grid. Each plot shows the spatial distribution of the number of eggs per plant. 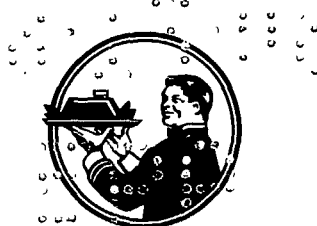
