On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the following label changes:
  - Change the EPA Reg. No. to read 73825-6.
  - The primary brand name "Biogenic Safety Brands" is an implied safety claim that is not acceptable for a product that contains the conventional pesticide piperonyl butoxide. You must submit for approval a primary brand name that is not an implied safety claim.
  - Revise the last sentence of the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals statements to read as follows:  
Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco.
  - Revise the first sentence of the If Swallowed statement as follows:  
Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

- Revise the Physical and Chemical Hazards statements to read as follows:  
**Flammable.** Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.
- This is a contact kill product with no support for implied claims of residual efficacy. Revise the directions for use as follows:  
Delete all “control” claims, which may be replaced with “kill” claims.  
Replace any and all directions to spray surfaces or areas with directions to spray insects directly.
- The following pest must be removed from the label: centipedes.
- Modify the claim to kill spiders as follows: “Spiders except Black Widow and Brown Recluse spiders.”
- Delete “Quick Knockdown”.
- Modify the claim “Crawling and flying insecticide” to read as follows: “Kills crawling and flying insects on contact only.”
- Modify the claim “Kills Most Common Household Pests” to read as follows: “Kills listed common household pests on contact only”.
- Modify the claim “Kills crawling and flying insects” to read as follows: Kills crawling and flying insects on contact only.”
- In a font no smaller than the font used in the directions for use, add the following statements to the directions for use (after “Shake well before using”) and to the front panel. In addition, the font must be bolded as follows:  
“**Kills only on contact**”.  
“**This product is a contact spray and will not prevent re-infestation of any listed pest in any treated area.**”
- Add the following statements to the directions for use (after “Shake well before using”) in a font no smaller than the font used in the directions for use. In addition, the font must be bolded as follows:  
“**Insects must be contacted by spray in order to ensure 100% mortality.**”
- Add the following to the directions for use, INDOORS, Carpenter Ants and OUTDOORS, Carpenter Ants in a font no smaller than the font used in the directions for use. In addition, the font must be bolded as follows:  
“**Fire ants and carpenter ants – this product will not kill ant queens or ant colonies.**”
- Add the following statements to the directions for use in a font no smaller than the font used in the directions for use.  
“Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Contact fleas and ticks directly to kill these pests.”

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Within 30 days, submit two copies of the revised final printed label.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

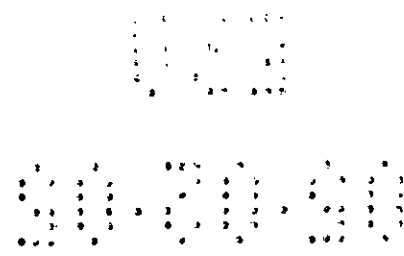

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**INDOORS**

Hold container upright. Remove cap and direct spray away from face. Hold can 12-15 inches from surface being sprayed. Press button down and spray as directed.

**CRAWLING INSECTS:** To control *ants, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, fleas, millipedes, pillbugs, silverfish* and *spiders*, apply as a crack & crevice treatment around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors & windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers, bookcases and similar areas. When pests are driven out, spray directly.

**Fleas & Brown Dog Ticks** on surfaces: Remove pet bedding and destroy or clean thoroughly. Spray pet resting quarters. Fleas and ticks contacted by spray will be killed. Put fresh bedding down once spray has dried. Do not spray animals directly. For best results, pets should be treated with an appropriate flea and/or tick control product registered for use on pets before allowing them to return to the treated area. Spray rugs and carpets where infestations are bad. Delicate fabrics should be tested for staining in an inconspicuous area prior to use.

**Carpenter Ants:** For effective control, locate and treat nests and surrounding areas. Apply around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide.

**Carpet Beetles:** Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other areas where these insects are found.

**FLYING INSECTS:** For contact kill of *house flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths* and *lady beetles*, aim spray toward infestations around windows and other light sources contacting as many insects as possible.

**OUTDOORS**

Point nozzle away from face. Hold can approximately 12-15 inches from surface to be sprayed. For best results, spray when air is calm. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing. Do not contaminate fish ponds or apply directly to water.

**CRAWLING INSECTS:** To control *ants, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, fleas, brown dog ticks, millipedes, pillbugs, silverfish* and *spiders*, apply to cracks & crevices outside of buildings, around screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages, garbage cans and similar areas where insects may congregate or enter premises. For *ants*, spray trails, hills and nests.

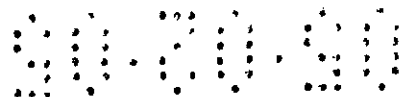
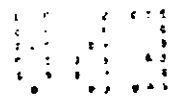
**FLYING INSECTS:** For contact kill of *house flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, wasps, hornets, yellow jackets* and *lady beetles*, aim spray toward infestations on outside of buildings, around windows and door frames, on decks, patios, carports, porches and similar areas contacting as many insects as possible. Avoid spraying plants with this product. If plants are contacted by spray, rinse thoroughly with water.

**\*\*Biogenic Safety Brands Household Insect Killer** should not stain surfaces such as vinyl or painted siding. However, since it is impossible for the manufacturer to test all surfaces under all conditions, good application practices recommend that you test the spray in an inconspicuous area when treating a new surface.
