**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

1. Only for formulation into a fungicide for the following sites of use: celery, cereals (barley, oats, rye, wheat), corn, grasses for seed, peanuts, pecans, pineapples, rice, stone fruit, sugarcane, turf, and ornamentals.
