

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Intace Fungicide B-350 is intended for use as an industrial fungicide for the control of fungal growth on exterior paint and coatings, adhesives, caulks and sealants, exterior plaster coatings, architectural coatings and coatings for wallboard, gypsum cores in wallboard and ceiling tiles, insulation covering, and aqueous and solvent based paper and paperboard applications.

NOT FOR USE IN COATINGS, ADHESIVES, PAINTS, CAULKS, SEALANTS, OR PAPER THAT WILL COME IN CONTACT WITH FOOD.

It is chemically inert and will not react with the other ingredients in the solution. In Industrial Use Settings Only: Add Intace Fungicide B-350 to the exterior paint and coatings, adhesives, caulks and sealants, exterior plaster coatings, and architectural coatings, and coatings for wallboard and insulation covering at levels of 2 gallons/1000 gallons to 20 gallons/1000 gallons depending on the substance to be protected, the fungal hazard, and the duration of the product desired. For gypsum cores in wallboard and ceiling tiles, add Intace Fungicide B-350 to the wet gypsum during the manufacturing process at levels in the range of 0.2 to 1 gallon per 1000 square feet.

For aqueous and solvent based non food paper and paperboard applications including:

- packaging soap bars
- manufacturing file folders, boxes and other storage devices for items to be stored for long periods
- · coverings for insulation, wallboard and other construction materials
- · hottle labels and other labels

Use at levels of 350 ppm – 1500 ppm active ingredient in the paper

It is the responsibility of the formulator to test Intace Fungicide B-350 for optimum dosage levels and to determine compatibility and suitability for the intended use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store this product in a cool dry area, away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration. In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water.

Pesticide Disposal: Product or rinsates that cannot be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer.

Container Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Fill the container ¼ full with water and reclose the container. Agitate vigorously, and dispose of rinsate consistent with pesticide disposal instructions. Repeat two more times. Then offer for recycling if available, or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration.
