d. Within the First Aid section, revise the eye statement to read as follows:

"Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing.

Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice."

e. Within the First Aid section, revise the inhalation statement to read as follows:

"Move person to fresh air.

If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.

Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice."

f. Revise the Environmental Hazards section to read as follows:

"Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

- 3. Submit the following information to satisfy the data gaps in the data base for clothianidin. The following information is required within three (3) years of the date of this Notice:
  - a. Submit an acceptable Developmental Immunotoxicity study.
  - b. Submit acceptable rotational crop residue field trials with mature soybeans.
  - c. Submit additional analysis of test the materials used in the previously submitted mutagenicity studies. Please refer to the Human Health Risk Assessment for Clothianidin dated May 1, 2003 by EPA's OPP Health Effects Division for specific details regarding the information that should be included in this analysis.
  - d. Submit an acceptable Whole Sediment Acute Toxicity to Freshwater Invertebrates study.

- e. Submit an acceptable Field Test for Pollinators. Please refer to the EFED Risk Assessment for the Seed Treatment of Clothianidin dated February 20, 2003 and addendum dated April 10, 2003 by EPA's OPP Environmental Fate and Effects Division for specific details regarding the information that should be included in this test.
- f. Submit an acceptable Aerobic Aquatic Metabolism study.
- g. Submit an acceptable Seed Leaching study. Please refer to the EFED Risk Assessment for the Seed Treatment of Clothianidin dated February 20, 2003 by EPA's OPP Environmental Fate and Effects Division for specific details regarding the information that should be included in this study.
- 4. This registration is time-limited and will termite on May 30, 2006 unless renewed by EPA.
- 5. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
