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DIRECTIONS FOR FIRE ANTS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

What it kills: Fire Ants

How to use: Mound Treatment Only

Where to use: Lawns, Commercial Grounds, Golf Courses, Landscaped Areas, Parks, Common Land (not to be used indoors)

This product is only for use in non-feed/non-food/non-crop areas.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

MIXING AND MEASURING: Dilute at a rate of 5/8 oz. of product (2/3 cup of product) per gallon of water (do not use kitchen utensil).

How to apply: Mix thoroughly, using a garden spouted bucket or other appropriate equipment, gently drench the mound completely until the tunnels are exposed (no more than one gallon mixture per mound of one foot diameter). Treat the mound when the ants are active (when soil temperature is greater than 46F). Additional treatment may be necessary if excessive precipitation occurs within 24 hrs. after application. If soil is extremely dry, wet mound and surrounding area with water before treatment. Reapplication may be required for larger mounds. Allow 14 days before reapplication. Mix only enough mound drench to be used at one time. Do not store mixture overnight.

DIRECTIONS FOR WHITEFLY

This product is only for use in non-food/ non-feed/ non-crop areas.

What it kills: Whitefly

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

When to use: Spray when insects or damage first appear.

Mixing and Measuring: Dilute at a rate of 5.8 oz. of product (2/3 cup of product) per gallon of water (do not use kitchen utensil).

How to apply: Use a hand held sprayer or other appropriate equipment thoroughly spray all infested areas to the point of runoff, hitting insects directly. 1 gallon spray treats 1,000 sq. ft.

Repeat application at 4 to 10 day intervals as needed. Mix only enough spray to be used at one time. Do not store mixture overnight.

For Use On: Ornamentals, Flowers, Woody Landscape Shrubs and Trees
