The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided the following changes are incorporated in the labeling:

- In the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section, after the statement "Harmful if inhaled", insert the following language: "Do not breath the vapor or spray mist".
- In the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section, after the wording "handling and before eating..." insert the following language: "drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco". Remove and Wash contaminated clothing before reuse".
- In the ADDED PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS FOR FINISHED BLENDS section, insert the following language in the beginning of the statement: "Do not breath vapor or spray mist".
- Specific organisms, particularly those in which efficacy testing were conducted on this product to support the disinfection claim, needs to be included in the labeling.

FIRST AID

Mixing and Usage Instructions: DO NOT MIX IN METAL CONTAINERS


Pour the complete contents of the EasyDECON Part 1 (EPA Reg. No. 74436-1) container into a mixing container (plastic or glass), large enough to hold an using to bacco. Remote all three components when completely mixed. Add the complete contents of the EasyDECON Part 2 (EPA Reg. No. 74436-2) container into the mixing container holding EasyDECON Part 1 (EPA Reg. No.74436-1) and stir the solution until it is thoroughly mixed (15 - 20 seconds). Add the complete contents of the Booster container into the mixing container holding EasyDECON Part 1 (EPA Reg. No. 74436-1) and EasyDECON Part 2 (EPA Reg. No. 74436-2) and stir the solution until it is thoroughly mixed (15 -20 seconds). The mixture is now ready to apply

> FOR USE ON: Floors, counters, bathroom fixtures and surfaces, painted wood surfaces, exterior surfaces of refrigerators, stoves, etc. by thoroughly wetting with an application device such as a brush, mop, coarse sprayer or foam applicator. Apply the mixture at the rate of 1 gallon per 30,000 cubic feet (1L/225M³) as a coarse spray. Apply the mixture at the rate of 1 gallon per 85 square feet (1L/2M2) for liquid and foam applications.

Contact time for contaminated surfaces: After using one of the above methods to apply the mixture, keep the surfaces wet for 10 minutes. The mixture must be reapplied if it dries out or becomes diluted by any liquid during the 10 minute contact time.
