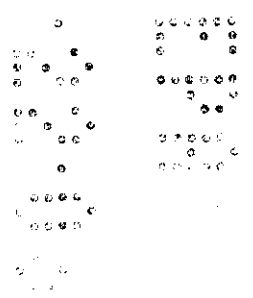

2. Reposition the precautionary signal word and precautionary statements; and
3. Adding the statement "See enclosed product insert for Directions for Use and First Aid Statements"

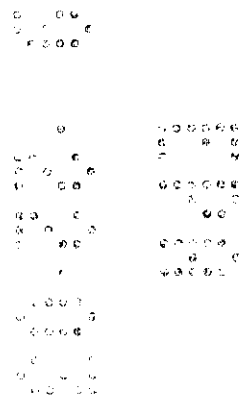

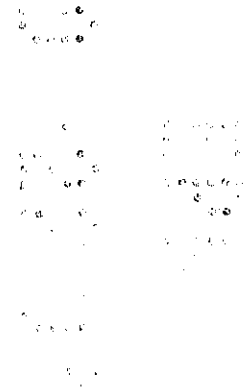

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING,

Sugar ants are usually found in kitchen and bathrooms searching for food. This bait is most successful when competing sources of food are sealed up and put away. This product is designed against Ghost ants, *Tamponoma melanocephalum*, and other sweet feeding ants.

Ant-fix is very thick, no-drip, high grip formulation that allows the use on walls, under the counter, and flat surfaces. Locate the foraging sugar ants*. Depress the plunger to dispense the bait in front of the foraging ant. Dispense about 1/2-1 inch of bait in each location. Dispense more bait in the ants trail and near their points of entrance to the house such as windows, doors, and cracks.

If the tip of the syringe gets clogged due to the formation of solids, clear by using a paper clip.

*Place bait in areas inaccessible to children and pets.
