**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

This product is intended for use only by formulators in preparing end-use fungicides in accordance with the stipulations noted below for use sites such as ornamental plants, and wood or wood structure protection treatments, and paint additive products, adhesives, coatings, resin emulsions, paint films and the surfaces they cover. This product may be formulated into products labeled for turf uses only on sod farms and golf courses. Do not use for formulating into products intended for sod farm uses at application rates greater than 13 pounds active ingredient, per acre, per year.

This product must not be formulated into pesticide products applied by low pressure hand wands to turf sites unless the formulated product is labeled to require the applicator use of a dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C), or a NIOSH approved respirator with any R,P, or HE filter.
