Add to the bottom of the First Aid Statements the following:

Note to Physician: Contains petroleum distillate. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

In accordance with the Reregistration Eligibility Decision (RED) issued September 23, 2003, add the following to the Directions for Use:

For use in animal quarters only. Do not broadcast outdoors.
Remove animals from quarters before treating premises.

Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read as follows:

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate.
