 - c) Under Spreader Tips, move the footnote "When using other spreaders calibrate..." to the body of the table under Directions, so it relates to spreaders Central Imperial 1662 thru EZ Broadcast Republic 540.
 - d) Based on the acute toxicity profile of this product, the only first aid label statements required are the "If on skin or clothing" statements. If you choose to keep the other first aid statements, list the "If on skin" statements first.
 - e) Revise the precautionary statements to read: "Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling

and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

- f) Under Conditions of Sale revise the statement beginning with: "In no event shall Product & Regulatory Associates LLC or seller be liable..." to read: "To the extent permitted by law Product & Regulatory Associates LLC or seller shall not be liable...".
