DANGER

FIRST AID

Registrants or formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registrations of their products.

This product may be used in combination with other non-pesticidal products provided no pesticide claim is made.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed or storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Keep material dry and in a dry area. Store in original container where temperatures do not exceed 125°F (52°C) for 24 hours. Keep container tightly closed.
