DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mix STORSHIELD ZB into the adhesive, wax, slurry or polymer to be used in the wood composite, plastic, or coating until uniform. Proceed with the composite mixing process. STORSHIELD ZB should be added a rate of 0.5 to 4.0% of the total weight of wood composite to be treated.

FIRST AID
