PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. When mixing this product for application, wear chemical resistant gloves. When applying this product wear a dust mask (particle mask). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before smoking or eating. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Handle concentrate in ventilated area. May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. If sensitization reactions result consult a physician and avoid future use or contact with painted surfaces.

FIRST AID

This product contains diazinon, an organophosphate insecticide that inhibits cholinesterase.
If Swallowed: Immediately call a physician or Poison Control Center. Sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by Poison Control or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing.
If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call Poison Control or doctor for treatment advice.
If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present after the first 5 min. then continue rinsing eye. Call a doctor or Poison Control for advice.
If Inhaled: Move victim to fresh air. If not breathing call 911 or ambulance and give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.
Note to Physician: Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, Atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

Environmental Hazards

This product is highly toxic to birds, fish and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes, and estuaries. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Reformulation or repackaging of this product is prohibited. Read entire label. Do not open container except for immediate use.
For use as an additive for paints or stains for application outside on exterior surfaces of homes only.
Mixing Directions: Add on full container to one (five) gallon(s) of latex water base paint, oil base paint or stain then mix well to insure proper dilution. Do not add more than one ounce to one gallon of paint.


