


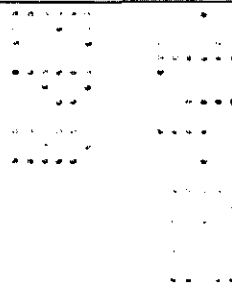

ChitoSante' should always be applied to textiles during the dyeing process, at a ratio of 1 part ChitoSante' to 50 - 100 parts soft water. Apply approximately 1-2% ChitoSante' relative to the dry weight of the textiles. The textile materials should be soaked in this bath solution to achieve good saturation and penetration of fibers. After soaking, textile materials should be dried at a temperature of 70-170 degrees C.

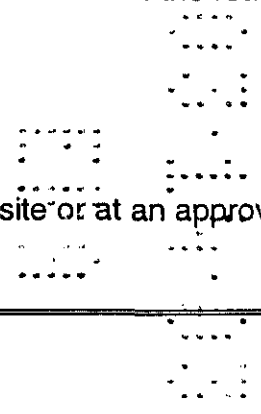
