DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Note:** This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage, as necessary, to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

TO DISINFECT HARD, NON-POROUS SURFACES:

First, clean surface by removing gross filth (loose dirt and debris, etc.). Using a coarse spray, thoroughly wet surface with dilution of 1 part of the product to 9 parts water (5,000 ppm available chlorine) and allow it to remain in contact with the surface for 10 minutes. Rinse with clean water and dry.

USE SITES and SURFACES: For use in hospitals, laboratories, commercial, institutional and veterinary premises. For use on hard non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, ceilings, doors, glazed tiles, countertops, cabinets and equipment surfaces.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER: Corrosive, may cause severe skin and eye irritation or chemical burns to broken skin. Can cause eye damage. Wear safety glasses and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash after handling. Avoid breathing vapors. Vacate poorly ventilated areas as soon as possible until strong odors have dissipated.

Physical and Chemical Hazards
