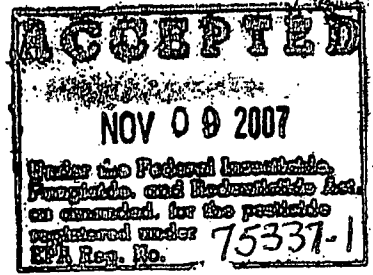

FIRST AID STATEMENT

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: For commercial grower use. For use on all nursery stock cuttings including woody ornamentals, deciduous hardwoods, evergreens, ground covers, and perennials.

Be sure the propagation media is moist before planting. *Do not dilute Hormogel*. Pour Hormogel into a small container. Quick dip the cutting, hold the cutting before sticking in the media and keep moist for 10-15 minutes to help Hormogel penetration. Keep the cuttings moist by misting. Start watering after 12 to 24 hours.

Tips to Enhance Rooting: Make a ½ to ¾ inch longitudinal wound on the site of the cuttings with a sharp knife to expose the cambium. Cover the cuttings after dipping with a moist cloth and hold for 15 to 20 minutes before sticking. After sticking, cover the flats with porous Geotextile fabric such as Remy for 2 to 3 weeks. Keep moist and water when needed. Do not drench the cuttings with fungicides until roots form. Some fungicides can inhibit root formation. For harder to root plants, leave the cuttings in the

Hormogel for 5 to 15 minutes or longer before sticking. Always do a small test before large scale use. Bottom heat is helpful during cold weather. Water carefully to prevent root diseases. Do not pour *used* Hormogel back into original container.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE:

Store in original container in cool, dry locked place out of reach of children and pets.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
