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b. Revise the Precautionary statements to read:

"Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses, appropriate protective clothing and chemical-resistant gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

(Note: The gloves must be chemical resistant gloves such as nitrile or butyl gloves)

c. Revise the First Aid statements to read:

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing.
Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on Skin: Take off contaminated clothing.

4. Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed label bearing the revisions prior to releasing this product for sale.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hollow Heart CF is designed for remedial treatment of in-service poles, piling, posts, and other timber members.

Stir before using. Dilute 1 gallon of this concentrate with 1 1/2 gallons of water. Shake or stir well. Using air or mechanical pressure pump, apply solution to interior cavity of wood structure through prepared opening. Apply one gallon (maximum per cu. ft. of wood) or to refusal.

Application of this product may produce a strong, lingering unpleasant odor.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a secure, well-ventilated area protected from extreme temperatures. Do not transfer to unmarked containers. Keep container closed when not in use.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Puncture and dispose of in sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Hollow Heart CF contains recognized salt preservatives used successfully in the art of wood preservative for more than forty (40) years. This combination of sodium fluoride and copper naphthenate provides deep, long lasting protection against decay.

Hollow Heart CF is designed for use in treatment of standing poles, piling and other timber members.
