### GENERAL INFORMATION:

This product contains a fast-acting fish toxicant which kills snails in aquaculture ponds. The mode of action is uncoupling of oxidative phosphorylation. As many types of non-target species are potentially vulnerable to Bayluscide®-M, it is necessary to use care and to follow the requirements of this label to minimize impacts. Only use Bayluscide®-M when planning to stock or restock a pond.

### USE RESTRICTIONS:

#### Use Pattern:

#### **FOR CONTROL OF SNAIL POPULATIONS IN AQUACULTURE PONDS.**

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR MIXING AND APPLICATION:**

For control of freshwater snails, mix 1.5 pounds of Bayluscide®-M 70% Wettable Powder to be distributed over each acre foot of water to be treated for snails. For optimal control, it is better to drain pond to one (1) foot or less. Drain pond early enough for snails on bank of pond to follow the water down before treatment. Treat entire bottom of water in pond with air boat, chemical boat or spray rig.

**Example:** To treat a ten (10) acre pond with one (1) foot of water: 10 (acre pond) X 1 (acre foot) = 10 acre feet X 1.5 pounds of product = 15 pounds of product. Mix Bayluscide®-M with enough water to assure distribution of 1.5 pounds of product per acre foot of pond bottom. Mixture should be distributed over entire surface of pond for complete snail control. It is important that

you mix well with water and distribute evenly across the water in the bottom of the pond. For best results in snail eradication, allow product to stay in pond bottom for 48 to 72 hours before pumping or adding additional water into pond. Fill pond to normal level and allow two weeks before adding fry to treated pond. Before restocking after treatment, place fish in a net or basket and place in treated water. IF after 24 hours, fish are alive, restock pond with fry.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** This is a non-food use product. DO NOT HARVEST FISH FOR 12 MONTHS AFTER APPLICATION OF BAYLUSCIDE®-M 70% WETTABLE POWDER. Do not use treated water to irrigate crops or allow humans or livestock to consume treated water. Do not apply in a way that will cause the concentrated product to contact unprotected workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Keep label and MSDS with you at all times.

**RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE.** When applying this product, do not apply in a way that will cause the concentrated product to contact unprotected workers or other persons, either directly or through drift.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**
