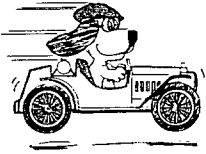

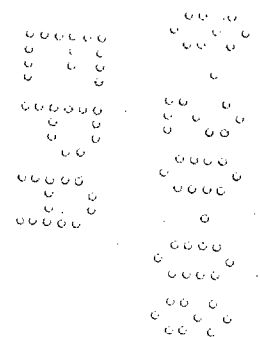

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Household Treatment:

Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind base boards, moldings, window and doorframes, and entire areas of floor and floor covering. Place fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Repeat treatment as needed.

On Pets:

Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and underbody. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes or face. Avoid contact with genitalia. Reapply daily as needed
